7. Look at 1 Timothy 6:9-10. Why does Timothy say the love of money is the root of all kinds of evil? Is money bad? Or is it our attitude about money?
8. Look at what Jesus says in Mark 10:27. How do you interpret his words? Have you ever experienced something in your life that was impossible for you, but possible for God?
9. If you had to choose one verse that stands out to you from Mark 10:17-27, what would it be?
10. Is there something that holds you back from following Christ 100%? If so, what is it? How can the group pray for you?
