## Week 7: Easter Sunday follow up

### Questions for this week:

1. If you were at OHCC on Sunday, what stood out to you from the Easter service? How did God speak to you? What part(s) of the service touched you most?
2. Scott talked about the evidence around the resurrection, but he said our response to Jesus still comes down to faith. In what way does the life and resurrection of Jesus impact your life? Has it changed you in any way? If so, how?
3. Read John 20:19-23. What fear kept the Disciples locked up in a room? Have you ever felt “locked up” in fear?
4. What did Jesus say when he appeared to the Disciples? Is there an area of your life right now where you need God’s peace?
5. Jon talked about fear, and how it can cripple us in our faith. Is there a fear that is keeping you from living freely in your faith?
6. Read John 18:15-18,25-27. Why do you think Peter denied Christ right after he was arrested? Have you ever had an experience where you felt like you “denied” Christ? If so, when?
7. Laurie talked about the fact that Jesus believes in us before we can believe in ourselves. Have you experienced this in your life? If so, how?
8. Read John 21:15-19. Why did Jesus ask Peter 3 times if he loved him? What do you think his purpose was in asking this question?
9. Peter goes on to live out God’s purpose for his life, and becomes the “rock” of the church (see Acts 1-2). Do you feel like you are living out God’s purpose for your life? If so, what is it? If not, what is keeping you from it?
