Questions for this week:

1. Have you had a moment where you received Christ into your life? If so, when?
2. If you were in a car with Christ, and the car represented your life, who would be in the Driver's seat- you or Him?
3. Read Colossians 2:6-8. What part of this verse most applies to where you are in your spiritual journey?
 - need to receive Christ (still haven't committed myself to Him)
 - need to "live in Him" (want to spend more time with Him)
 - need to be "rooted and built up in Him" (want to go deeper and grow in my faith)
 - need to be "strengthened in the faith" (want to open myself more to community)
4. Look at Matthew 16:24. What do you think Jesus is saying here about what it means to be a Christ follower? Would you describe yourself as a Christ follower?
5. How do you currently cultivate your relationship with God? Do you set aside time to be with Him? If so, what do you do in that time?
6. Would you consider going on the One Day Spiritual retreat this Saturday (8:30-3:30 at the Michealsens)? Why/Why not?
7. Read the Parable of the 4 soils (Matthew 13:v3-9;v18-23). Which soil best describes where you are in your relationship with Christ?
8. Laurie talked about the need for community to support each other, speak/hear the truth, and learn discernment (the ability to listen to the right voices). How is your small group doing with these things? Is there anything you can do better?
